SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Intended Use


The following safety guidelines are intended to prevent unforeseen risks or damage from unsafe or incorrect operation of the appliance. Please check the packaging and appliance on arrival to make sure everything is intact to ensure safe operation. If you find any damage, please contact the retailer or dealer. Please note modifications or alterations to the appliance are not allowed for your safety concern. Unintended use may cause hazards and loss of warranty claims.

Explanation of Symbols

	Danger This symbol indicates that there are dangers to the life and health of persons due to extremely flammable gas.

Safety Instructions

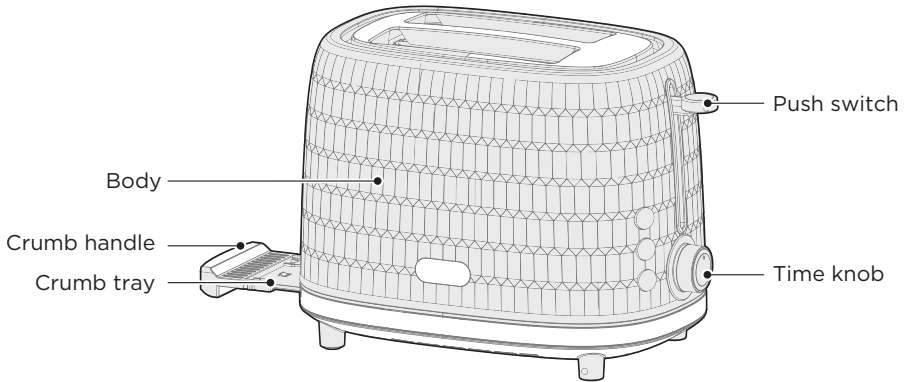
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- The appliance must not be immersed.
- Do not use outdoors

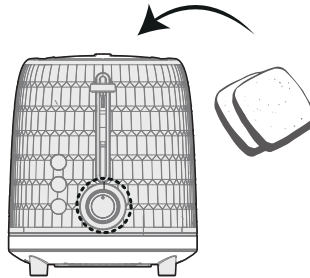

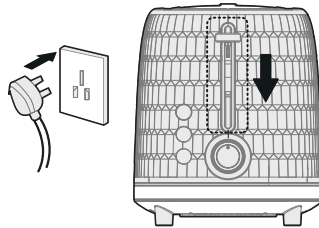
Instructions for Use

Tips

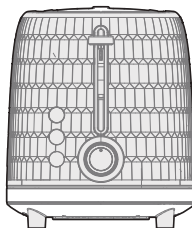
- Remove the dust cover before use.
Adjust the time knob, which has 7 levels available; the larger the number, the more brown the bread surface is.
 - After setting the browning degree of the bread, you can put the bread in the oven.
 - Turn on the power and press the push switch to start baking.
 - After baking, the bread will automatically pop up and the product will stop working.
 - To continue baking, please repeat the above operations. If you don't need to continue baking, pull out the plug and store the product after it has cooled.
1. Adjust the time knob to select the browning degree of the bread, and then put in the bread.



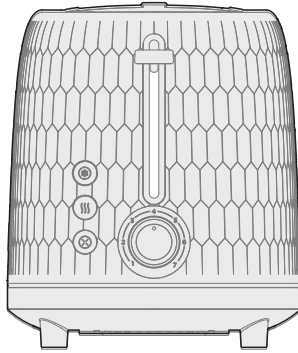
2. Turn on the power, and press the push switch to start baking.






3. After the baking is completed, the bread pops out automatically and the product stops working.

Icon	Button	Button description
	Defrost	Frozen bread, thawed before baking, tastes better. The working time is longer than normal baking time.
	Reheat	For the cooled bread, use this function button to restore the warm taste after baking. The working time is shorter than the normal baking.
	Cancel	Press this button, the bread will pop up automatically and the product will stop working.

NOTE

- The above baking time is tested at room temperature 25°C and rated for 2 slices of bread. The actual time may be different.
- The size and thickness of the bread have an effect on the baking time.

Explanation of Symbols for the Function Keys

This Symbol is used to Cancel toasting.

Operation

1. Only connect the appliance to a correctly installed safety plug (220-240V- 50/60Hz).
2. Turn the selector switch clockwise to set the toasting level from the lightest stage 1 to the darkest stage 7.
If in any doubt, start with the lower setting (the black mark on the selector switch shows you the setting).
3. Insert sliced bread into the toasting slot and push down the lever until it locks.
4. The appliance starts toasting. The appliance switches off immediately once the set degree of toasting has been reached. The toast then pops up automatically.
5. The appliance has heat-insulated casing. However, as metal parts still heat up during operation, please allow cooling down before you put it away.
6. The toaster only allowed 2 slices of the toaster to be toasted at a time.

Guarantee

We accept a guarantee period of 12months for the appliance we have sold from the date of purchase (receipt).

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Before cleaning the appliance, ensure it is disconnected from the power supply and has cooled completely.
- To avoid the risk of electric shock, do not clean the appliance with water and do not immerse it in water.
- Do not use abrasives or harsh cleaning solutions.
- The body of the appliance may be wiped with a dry or slightly damp lint-free cloth.

Crumb Tray


- Crumbs and baking residues are collected in the crumb tray.
- Pull out the tray and empty it regularly. Make sure to put the crumb tray back in place before using the toaster again.
- Repairs can be carried out by licensed dealers or the repair services after the end of the guarantee period, but are subject to charge.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Operation of your appliance can lead to errors and malfunctions. The following tables contain possible causes and notes for resolving an error message or malfunction. It is recommended to read the table below carefully in order to save your time and money that may cost for calling to the service center.

Abnormal phenomena	Cause	Solution
Not work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The plug is not inserted properly.	Check plugs
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Loose connecting wire.	Send to the after-sales service point for maintenance
Other problems	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Other faults of the product.	Send to the after-sales service point for maintenance
